

WAT is it?

A brand new, user friendly tool that enables easy analysis of NHS Digital General Practice Workforce Census data. The General Practice Workforce Analysis Tool (GP WAT) allows comparison of workforce profiles per CCG or STP footprint or by individual practice, federation and locality level. The tool is an invaluable resource to commissioners, providers and practices in depicting comparators, understanding pressure points and how skill mix is changing.

WAT is the functionality?

Covers all CCGs and STPs in England and lists practices within their footprint. Four different graphs depict:

Population chart: The male/female distribution by age group, compared to the average for England for GPs, Nurses, Direct Patient Care practitioners and administration staff.


Distribution chart: Comparison of the distribution of patients per full time equivalent.

Scatter Plot: Where each of the practices in the selected STP or CCG sit in terms of the number of full time equivalents against the list size of the practice.

Head Count graph: Greater understanding of the specific workforce dynamic of the practices.

To co-ordinate and prioritise access to a comprehensive baseline of workforce information for Primary Care which is understandable and useable.


Future Development

Time Series analysis spreadsheet showing the changing picture of workforce data for practices, CCGs and STPs


A 'Deep Dive' spreadsheet to run a direct comparison between two practices, CCGs or STPs
