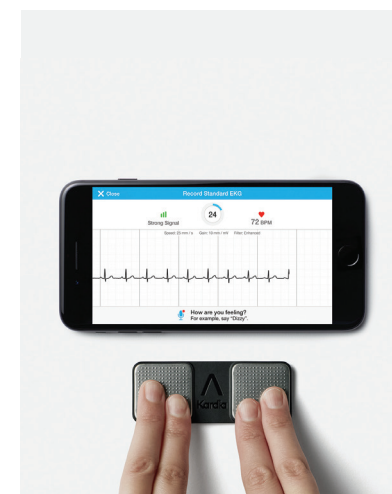
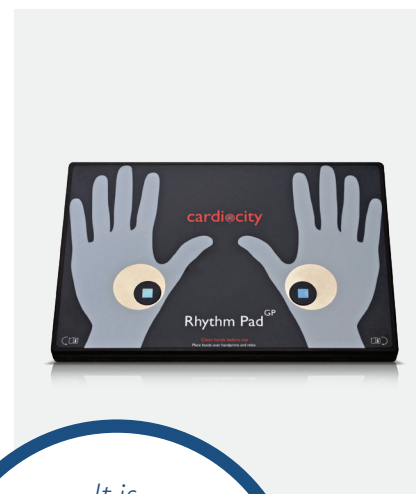


Detect Atrial Fibrillation Earlier and Reduce Strokes

New technology could allow you to detect atrial fibrillation (AF) earlier, which could reduce the risk of your patients having a stroke.

The AF detection devices offer an alternative to manual pulse checks. In most cases the devices provide you with a Lead 1 ECG trace enabling a decision over whether a 12 lead ECG is required to confirm diagnosis. Some devices can be loaned to patients if paroxysmal AF is suspected.
